The Project

This creative play project has been specially developed by leading children's arts organisation Giant. Through storytelling and visual arts, the project provides children aged 3-5 years with the space to imagine, create and engage in non-directed play.

Armed with their own creative toolbelts, and inspired by the setting, stimuli and themes around what makes a house a home, the children collaborate with professional artists to transform the *Little House* environment.

Curriculum for Excellence

The project has been developed in line with the Curriculum for Excellence and an accompanying resource pack of ideas will be given to all nurseries/groups involved so the experience can be continued back in the classroom/venue.

Practical Information

This is an ideal project for working in partnership with nurseries in your local area. The project will be resident in your nursery/venue for 5 days (Monday – Friday). On the Monday morning our artists will set up *Little House*. In the afternoon they will run one workshop. From Tuesday - Friday there will be one morning and one afternoon workshop. Each session holds a maximum 12 children. You will need a space at least 6m x 8m.



Cost

The project costs £3000 + VAT*. The cost includes:

- Two professional artists resident at your venue from Monday – Friday
- 9 creative workshops (1 hour)
- The capacity to engage with 108 nursery aged children



- All the materials and stimuli needed for the project
- A framed souvenir photograph of your class in the *Little House* environment
- A *Little House* Curriculum for Excellence linked resource pack
- Support in evaluating the project

*If your venue is more than 20 miles outside of Glasgow we would ask for a contribution towards the cost of travel and accommodation.
