Giant's creative two hour training courses have been designed in line with the Curriculum for Excellence. As well as the Expressive Arts, the skills learned will provide participants with the confidence and tools to implement creative activity across all curricular areas.

#### Courses

Below are the sessions available and a description of the course content. #### Scrap Art Sculpture/Model Making

**Stage of learning:** First, Second

Participants will explore producing 2 dimensional designs then constructing them into 3 dimensional models or sculptures using reclaimed and recycled materials.

Giant would be happy to discuss tailoring the themes of this session to fit in with current classroom projects.

#### Creative Play

**Stage of learning:** Early, First

Creative Play is a way of using different art-forms to engage creatively with young children, giving them the space to use their imagination and develop skills for everyday life. In this session learn new techniques for combining visual arts, movement, and drama games into cross artform activities for children of all abilities.

#### Making Your Mark

**Stage of learning:** Early, First, Second

An introduction to simple print-making for children. Participants will learn techniques for mono printing with a group/class. Explore creating vibrant, imaginative printed art works from the simplest of materials.

#### Making a Creative Space

**Stage of learning:** Early, First, Second

Learn how to develop an exciting playful environment for children to explore, be inspired by and create in. Use everyday materials such as paper, fabrics and card to construct the space, then explore how the space can be adapted and changed through the use of light, mirrors and projection. Participants will also learn accompanying themed activities to use within the space.

## Art Games

**Stage of learning:** First, Second

A workshop to arm participants with a more group orientated approach to art. The session will provide an introduction to games that combine the different facets of the arts with a fun approach. You will leave with a selection of tools that can be used simply for warm ups or as the forerunners that lead to a more detailed cross curricular projects.

## Art from the Cupboard

**Stage of learning:** Early, First, Second

Find exciting new ways to use old materials, pen, sticky tape, paper, plasticine and paint, through stories, play and themed creative activities.

Participants will be given ideas and suggestions on how to get the most from the art resources in your cupboard through a series of expressive arts games, creative activities and multi-sensory approaches to working with children.
